MedicareOnDemand is by your side every step of the way.
Here are key steps for making a smooth transition to Medicare.**

Step 1: Request for Information (Complete Now)

Completing the Request for Information form gets you connected to the right Medicare resources based on your specific needs and preferences. Indicate your Medicare questions and preferred method for gathering information. Return the optional form by mail or complete it online by visiting [MedicareOnDemand.com/Hillcrest-info](https://www.MedicareOnDemand.com/Hillcrest-info).

Step 2: MyChart (Register Now)

MyChart is your free online resource for checking lab results, scheduling healthcare appointments, and communicating with your healthcare providers. It is a free service and important for you to register with MyChart when becoming eligible for Medicare. Register by visiting: [MyChart.Hillcrest.com](https://www.MyChart.Hillcrest.com).

Step 3: Conduct Your Medicare Research (Complete 3-6 months before Medicare eligibility)

Learning about your Medicare benefits and insurance options is easier than you might think. *MedicareOnDemand* provides several resources for you including a Medicare Helpline, Medicare 101 seminars, Medicare Plan Quote Tool, and the online Medicare Education Center. Step 4: Compare and Enroll in a Medicare Plan (Enroll 2-3 months before Medicare eligibility)

It is very important to choose a Medicare plan that meets your specific healthcare needs and also includes all of your trusted healthcare providers. If you would like to talk to a licensed professional, Helpline insurance agents are standing by to assist by phone, and local insurance agents that specialize in Medicare are available by personal appointment. Step 5: Schedule Medicare Welcome Visit with primary care physician (PCP) (3 months before Medicare eligibility)

Medicare provides a free **Medicare Welcome Visit** for patients within their first year of Medicare eligibility. The Welcome Visit includes a review of your medical history and a discussion about important Medicare-covered preventive services. Schedule this free and important Medicare-covered service by contacting your primary care physician's office.

What are the advantages for patients using *MedicareOnDemand*?

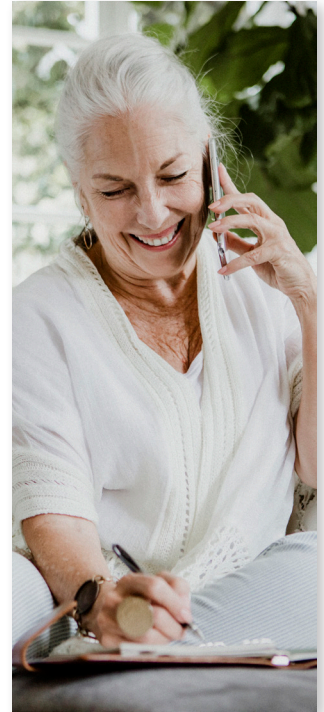
- There is never a cost or obligation for using the services of *MedicareOnDemand*.
