Turning 65 and Aging into **Medicare:**

Medicare is complex and can be confusing, so patients approaching Medicare eligibility (65th birthday) often turn to their physician and clinic staff for assistance. MedicareOnDemand provides patients with resources needed to make important decisions about their insurance coverage in their Medicare years. Patients who call the Helpline receive general Medicare information, as well as Plan Comparison and **Enrollment support! Licensed** insurance agents help patients choose a Medicare plan that best matches their specific needs, all while protecting patient continuity of care. Patients turning 65 years old have a specific window, called the "Initial Enrollment Period" to make a choice about their Medicare coverage. The Initial Enrollment Period is a 7-month period, that includes three months prior to the birth month, the birth month, and three months following the 65th birthday.

MedicareOnDemand is a non-government site hosted by MedicareCompareUSA, an independent health insurance agency not affiliated with the federal Medicare program. All services are provided at no cost and without obligation; MedicareCompareUSA and affiliated agents are paid directly by the Medicare plan when enrollment occurs. Healthcare providers receive no financial benefit when patients use the service. We do not offer every plan available in your area.
